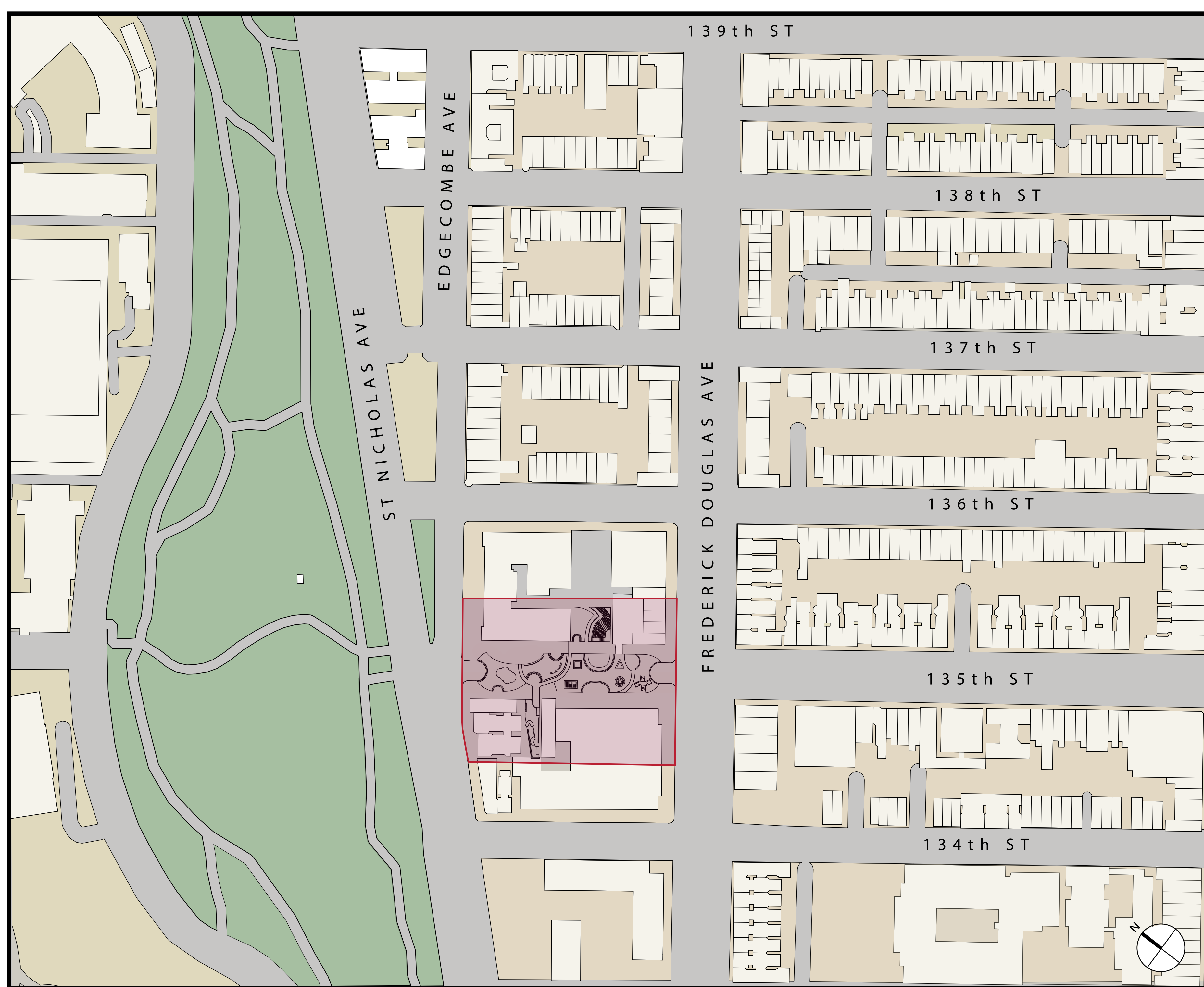
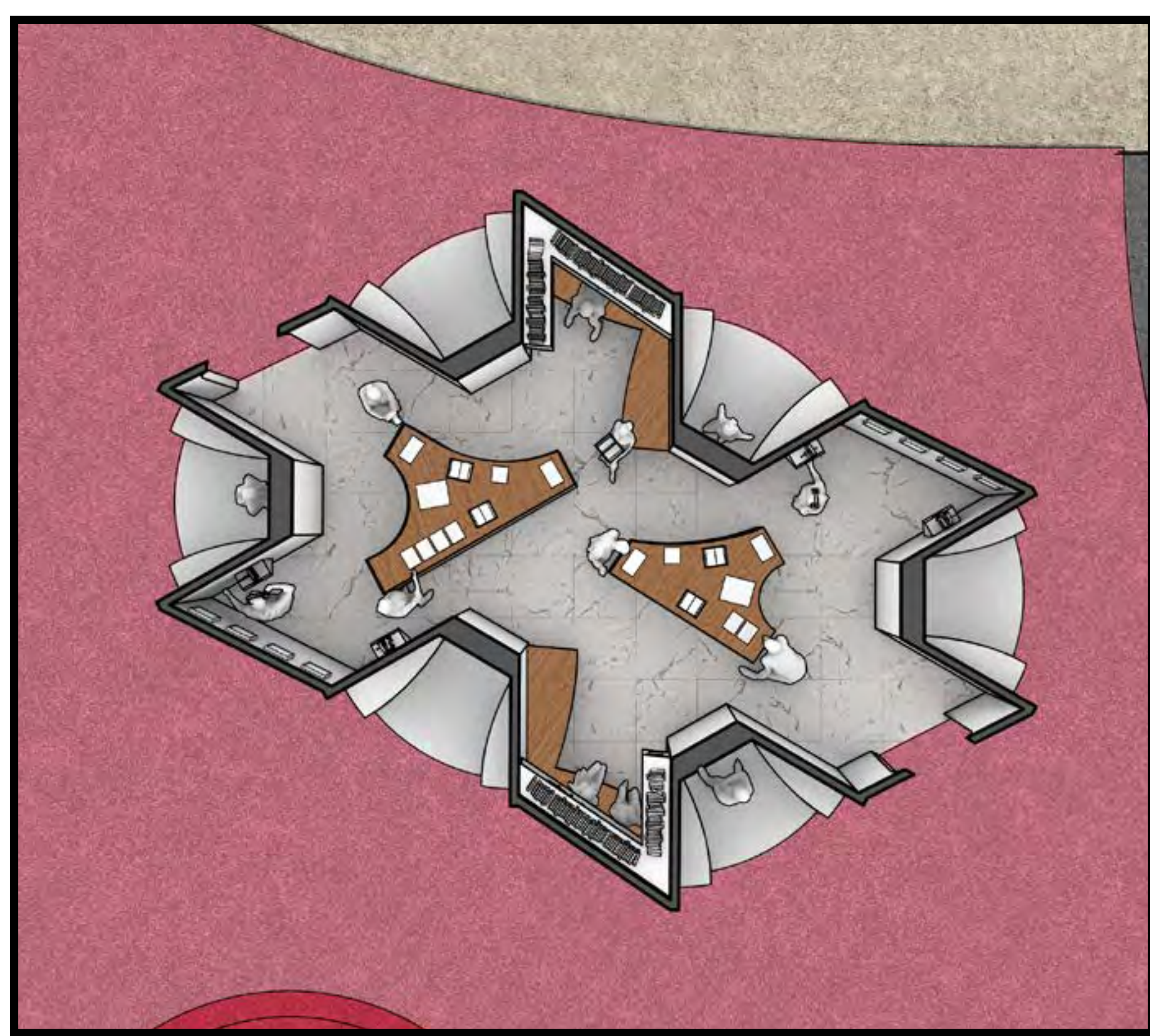


THE HARLEM ISLANDS

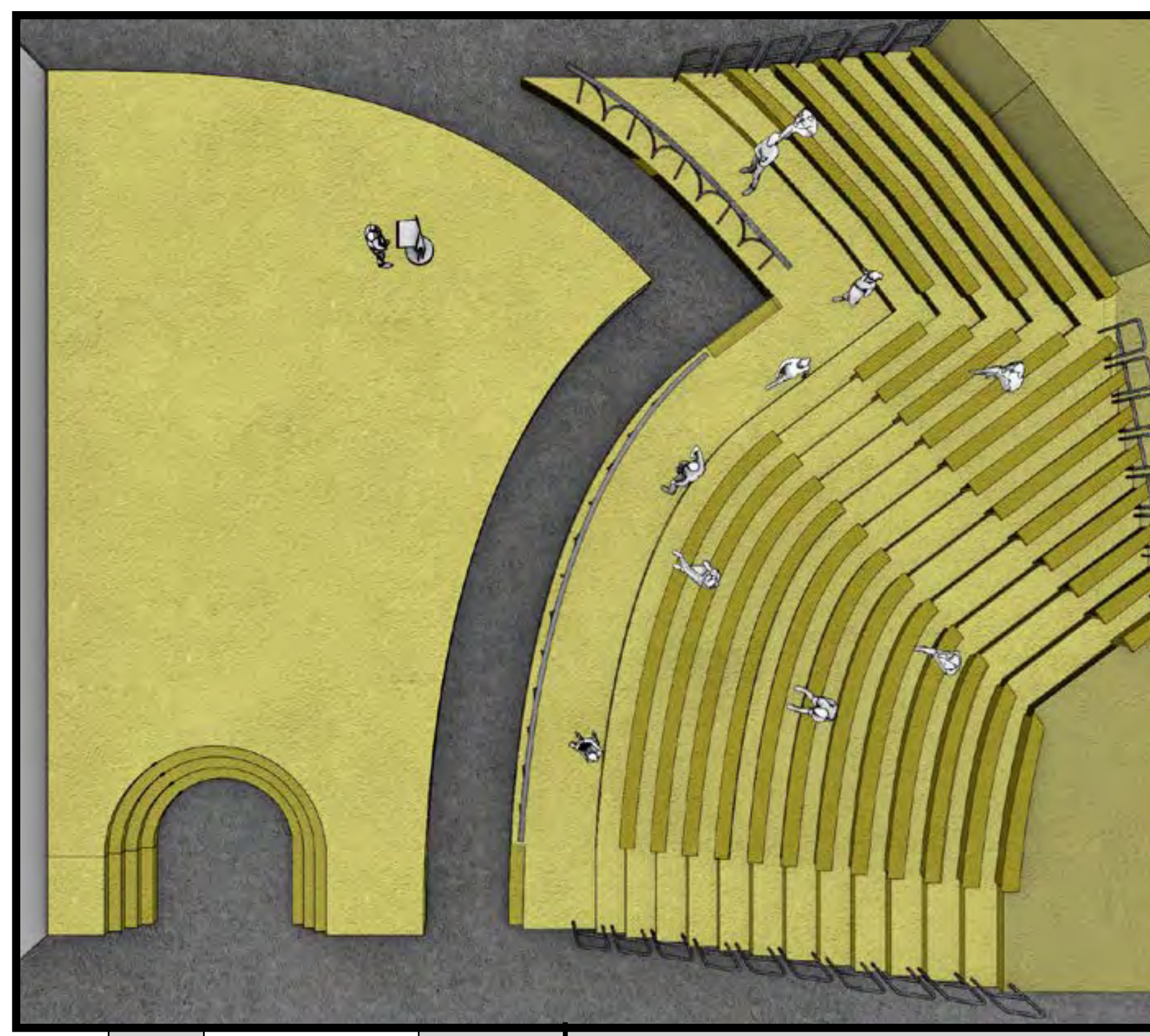
